

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

1. Students should always carry the Almanac to school.
2. No child should leave his/her classroom without the class pass/activity pass.
3. Lending or borrowing money and other articles is not permitted.
4. The school will not be responsible for any goods lost. Students are advised not to bring valuables like costly watches and fountain pens.
5. Students should use handmade jute or paper bags instead of poly-bags.
6. Permitted vehicles must be kept locked. Riding cycles or motor bike in the school premises is strictly prohibited.
7. Students who use the school bus should observe safely norms and conduct.
8. Students should obey House prefects, class monitors and other students on duty.
9. Students should attend school in proper uniform.
10. Students should not be allowed to leave the school during working hours, unless the authorized person, whose signatures are on the first page of the diary, comes in person to make the request.
11. Students should carry school identity cards to school everyday.
12. Students should be regular and punctual.
13. Students should not indulge in disruptive activities. Any loss or damage caused to the school property because of such activities will be reprimanded for the same.
14. The school has the right to take severe action against the students who are found guilty of misconduct and their names are liable to be removed from the school rolls.
15. Students should not carry mobile phones, i-pads or any other electronic gadgets to school.

SCHOOL UNIFORM & DRESS CODE

The School Uniform is a discipline in itself and should be adhered to by all the students. The set pattern and colour should be correctly followed. All students are expected to wear the School Uniform as specified. Parents are expected to ensure that their wards are in proper uniform before leaving for school. It is preferable to buy the uniform from the school uniform shop to ensure uniformity.

Uniform code

- Students should always be neatly dressed. The school uniform should be worn on all working days and for all school functions.
- Students who are untidily dressed or not in proper uniform will be sent back home.
- All boys (except Sikhs) must keep their hair short. Girls must tie their hair neatly.
- Girls are allowed to wear only small ear tops or studs. No other jewellery is permitted.
- Students are strictly prohibited from applying mehendi, nail polish or hair colour. Stringent action will be taken against defaulters.
